We are required to park in the former Coop Car Park not in the area immediately outside the hall. This area, referred to as the "Service Yard" is for drop-off and unloading only.

Members are asked to comply with these parking restrictions.

Please note CCTV cameras are in operation for enforcement.

# Where to Park at Community House when hosting or attending an event.

## Location

Community House, Meridian Way, Peacehaven, East Sussex, BN10 8BB is in the heart of Peacehaven, making it easily accessible by car.

## Meridian Centre Car Park

The entrance is located off Meridian way (green arrows on map)

- Just a short walk from Community House, approx. 2-4 minutes walk
- Free parking available 24hrs
- Ideal for most visitors
- Accessible Parking with bays close to the southern entrance of Community House
- Other parking can be found north of the Meridian Centre off of Roderick Avenue (<https://w3w.co/clapper.than.charge>) However access through the Meridian Centre is only available between 8am to 8pm.

## Important Notes

- Do not park in the southern service yard (circled in red on map) as this is for authorised vehicles such as emergency vehicles, deliveries and staff only. However, hirers are permitted to load and unload any equipment needed for their hire.
- Meridian car park height restriction on entry and exit of 2.1M / 6'11"
- Always check local signage for parking restrictions
- Avoid parking in the private or restricted areas
- Allow extra time during busy events
